....bad practice area etiquette

At the range:

-When you are finished hitting balls always clean up your hitting station. Do not leave towels, water bottles, empty soda cans, cigar butts, and the like lying around. Your mother would not want you to leave a mess.

At the short game area:

-Use as many tubes of balls as you want but when you are finished, gather all of them back up and return your tubes to their rightful place.

-Be cautious of your divots. Replace the big ones and step down on the divots so the grass might regenerate. Fix that array of ball marks you made as well.

-Rake the sand after you finish your bunker practice as you do on the course.

Be a good scout, when going to warm up or practice, no matter how soon your tee time is coming up, make sure to allot some time at the end to clean up behind yourself and leave the place as you found it.
